7 killed, 7 BSF men among many injured in Pak shelling

A SENIOR J-K government official and a two-year-old girl, were among those killed, officials said. Residents of Jammu city and other major towns of the division woke up to air raid sirens and deafening sounds of explosions around 5 am, while the border residents spent a sleepless night in the wake of intense shelling from across the border.



Raj Kumar Thapa, additional district development commissioner, Rajouri, and his two staff members were seriously injured when an artillery shell hit his official residence in Rajouri town, the officials said. They were rushed to the Government Medical College where Thapa succumbed to his injuries, they said. Condoling Thapa's death, Chief Minister Omar Abdullah said in a post on X, "Devastating news from Rajouri. We have lost a dedicated officer of the J-K Administration Services...I've no words to express my shock & sadness at this terrible loss of life. May his soul rest in peace." Two more persons — two-year-old Aisha Noor and Mohd Shohib (35) — were killed and three others were injured in Pakistani shelling near an industrial area in Rajouri town, the officials said. According to the officials, a 55-year-old

woman named Rashida Bi lost her life when a mortar shell hit her house at Kanghra-Galhatta village in Mendhar sector of Poonch district. In another incident, Ashok Kumar alias Shoki, a resident of Bidipur Jatta village, was killed in cross-border firing along the international border in the RS Pura sector of Jammu district, they said. Eight BSF personnel were injured in Pakistani shelling along the border in Jammu's RS Pura sector. One of them succumbed to his injuries and the rest are being treated. They are being treated at a military medical facility. Three more persons were also injured in intense shelling in Poonch and were evacuated to a hospital, officials said, adding that a local journalist was injured in the Nowshera sector of Rajouri. Several persons were injured when artillery shells and suspected drones hit some residential areas in Jammu, including Rehari and Roop Nagar in Jammu city.

What moved the needle?

RUBIO HAD ALREADY spoken to Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and the fact that he escalated it to the Pak army chief was telling. That this was a late development precipitated by the events of the last 48 hours — the blackouts and the attacks on either side — is clear from the chronology. On May 1, Rubio had spoken to external affairs minister S Jaishankar and "encouraged India to work with Pakistan to de-escalate tensions and maintain peace and security in South Asia." That was seen as a perfunctory call. On May 7, shortly after India struck at nine terror locations in Pakistan and PoK, NSA Ajit Doval briefed Rubio.

On May 8, Rubio spoke to Jaishankar and emphasised the need for "immediate de-escalation". He expressed "US support for direct dialogue between India and Pakistan and encouraged continued efforts to improve communications." This series of calls set the stage for what the US state department called a "US-brokered ceasefire between India and Pakistan" in its announcement. India insists that India and Pakistan came to an understanding bilaterally and there was "no third party involvement". Besides Rubio, US President Donald Trump and Vice-President J D Vance also talked about their role. "Over the past 48 hours, @VP Vance and I have engaged with senior Indian and Pakistani officials, including Prime Ministers Narendra Modi and Shehbaz Sharif, EAM S Jaishankar, Chief of Army Staff Asim Munir, and National Security Advisors Ajit Doval & Asim Malik," Rubio posted on X, giving the cast of characters and the phone lines that worked between Delhi, Washington DC, Islamabad and Rawalpindi. Vance, according to NYT, spoke to PM Modi. "Great work from the President's team, especially Secretary Rubio. And my gratitude to the leaders of India and Pakistan for their hard work and willingness to engage in this ceasefire," the USVP posted on X. After the May 7 strikes on headquarters of Lashkar-e-Taiba and Jaish-e-Mohammed in Pakistan, Delhi faced a barrage of drone attacks along the northern and western sectors of the border which it managed to intercept. On

May 8, it hit and destroyed the air defence system in Lahore. Pak's retaliation was aggressive in Jammu, Pathankot and Udhampur, as well as upto Jaisalmer. India was able to intercept about 400 drones because of its air defence system. But, then Pakistan attacked Srinagar in the early hours on May 10.

But the last three nights of tension after military hostilities, Delhi woke up on Saturday with a Pakistan attack that was intercepted in Sira — barely 240 km from Delhi. The target of locations like Chandigarh meant that the attacks and targets by Pak on India were not just confined to the north and western sectors of the India-Pakistan border. From the Indian perspective, the strategic imperative of peace was important, after it had established superiority against Pak — by defending itself in the face of barrage of drone and missile attacks. For Pak, Gen Munir was also able to convey to his domestic audience that Rawalpindi was not taking it lying down, and was able to respond aggressively against India. The needle moved in Washington DC as Pak got the IMF bailout package — despite India's abstention. This gave Islamabad an off-ramp, as it was able to portray a win — despite Delhi's objections. For Delhi, an uneasy peace has been secured — redlines on "terrorism have been drawn" — as an official source said that "any terror attack in future will be deemed as an act of war", and it has clearly said that other diplomatic and economic retaliatory steps will remain in place, including the abeyance of the World Bank-brokered Indus Water Treaty. The most challenging task will be that how long will the ceasefire hold — will be upto the two militaries and the establishment in Pak, led by Gen Munir and his NSA-cum-ISI chief Lt Gen Malik.

Excess deaths in line with pre-2020 trend, says govt

INDIA'S CUMULATIVE EXCESS mortality for 2020-2021 was 9.3% higher than expected deaths, a figure which was lower than that of the US, Italy and Russia, official sources said, referring to the latest Civil Registration System (CRS) data.

Sources pointed out that the number of deaths documented in the CRS has been increasing over time, even in the years preceding the Covid-19 outbreak in 2020, they said.

The excess mortality is the additional number of deaths, due to all causes during a crisis such as Covid-19, above the number of deaths expected to be reported during "normal" conditions.

The annual increment observed in a given year, compared to the previous year, has varied from 1.3% in 2016 to 9.93% in 2019, with the average increase over three preceding years (2016 to 2019) estimated at 6.42% per annum. The annual secular increase in deaths registered in CRS can be attributed to several reasons, including a larger population cohort, maturing reporting processes and increased awareness of the need for registration, leading to higher

registration levels, sources said. The annual secular increase is the long-term, consistent increase in deaths over a year. This trend has been further accentuated over the years by the mandatory requirements for death certificates linked to pension schemes, social security benefits, and property issues. Besides, Covid-19 death compensation required death certification, prompting registration under CRS, the sources stated. "Our teams conducted preliminary analyses of CRS data to assess cumulative excess deaths in the years 2020 and 2021," an official source said. Based on the three-year (2016-19), annual rate of

increase of 6.42% mentioned above, the expected number of deaths would be 81,31,869 in 2020 and 86,54,185 in 2021.

However, the observed deaths were 81,15,882 in 2020 and 1,02,24,506 in 2021. The excess deaths, defined as observed minus expected deaths, were (-15,987 and 15,70,311, respectively, the source said.

"Thus, the total excess deaths over the two-year period amounted to 15,54,334. As a percentage, this is 9.3% higher than the expected deaths. This translates into about 1,249 excess deaths per one million population," the source said.

It must be emphasised that excess deaths in these years are not equal to Covid-19 direct deaths, the source underlined.

These excess deaths include reported Covid-19 deaths (4,81,080 by the end of 2021), unreported Covid-19 deaths, deaths due to other causes, and possible indirect effects of Covid-19. "To benchmark these estimates, subject to more nuanced future analyses, we compared cumulative excess deaths in India for 2020 and 2021 with those of selected countries that provide publicly available data on excess mortality during the same period," the source said.

Ceasefire announced, broken

"IT WAS AGREED between them that both sides would stop all firing and military action on land and in the air and sea with effect from 1700 hours Indian Standard Time today. Instructions have been given on both sides to give effect to the understanding," he added. The DGMs will talk again at noon on May 12, he said. The United States, however, claimed credit for brokering the ceasefire.

Trump said the two countries agreed on a full and immediate ceasefire "after a long night of talks mediated by the United States". Secretary of State Marco Rubio said he and VP JD Vance "engaged with senior Indian and Pakistani officials, including prime ministers Narendra Modi and Shehbaz Sharif, external affairs minister Subrahmanya Jaishankar, chief of army staff Asim Munir, and national security advisers Ajit Doval and Asim Malik" over the last 48 hours. "We commend prime ministers Modi and Sharif on their wisdom, pru-

dence, and statesmanship in choosing the path of peace," he said in a press statement. Vance spoke with PM Modi, the New York Times said, quoting a person close to the Vice-President.

In his statement, Rubio also said India and Pakistan "have agreed...to start talks on a broad set of issues at a neutral site." This has been contested by Indian officials, who said all "coercive diplomacy measures" including the suspension of the Indus Water Treaty remain in place. External affairs minister S Jaishankar framed the ceasefire as the working out of an "understanding" between India and Pakistan. "India has consistently maintained a firm and uncompromising stance against terrorism in all its forms and manifestations. It will continue to do so," he posted.

Having drawn new redlines by conducting strikes on terror sites not just in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir but across the International Border deep inside

Pakistan, Jaishankar's assertion underlines that Islamabad will have to pay a heavy price for state-sponsored terrorism.

Sources said the decision to stop firing and military action was worked out "directly between the two countries", and there was "no third party involvement".

"The Pakistan DGMO initiated the call this afternoon, after which discussions took place and an understanding was reached. There is no decision to hold talks on any other issue at any other place," a source, who did not wish to be named, said. Further, there are "no pre-conditions" and "no post-conditions" to the understanding, the source said. Earlier in the day, after a phone conversation with Rubio, Jaishankar had said that India's approach has always been measured and responsible. Archery World Cup: India bag five medals



Madhura Dhamangaonkar strikes gold in Archery World Cup

CAPPING A DREAM comeback, Madhura Dhamangaonkar clinched her maiden individual World Cup gold to headline India's glittering medal collection in the compound section, two gold, one silver and two bronze at the Archery Stage 2 showpiece here on Saturday.

Unranked for being in the sidelines for three years, Madhura produced a sensational upturn in the final, edging out USA's Carson Krahe 139-138 to seal the top podium.

The 24-year-old from Amravati, Maharashtra, had earlier bagged a team silver and a mixed team bronze, completing a fine three-medal haul. However, Madhura's individual final was a roller-coaster affair. She opened with a perfect 30, including two Xs, but faltered with two 8s in the second end and a costly 7 in the third, trailing 81-85. Krahe, ranked 52nd and a World Cup team bronze medalist last year, capitalised with a perfect 30 in the third end. Under-terred, Madhura showed nerves of steel, shooting a near-flawless 29 in the fourth to level the match at 110-110.

US-China pursue Geneva talks on easing trade war

CHINESE VICE PREMIER He Lifeng held talks with US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent on Saturday in a tentative first step towards defusing a trade war that is disrupting the global economy. Bessent and He were meeting in Geneva after weeks of growing tensions in which duties on goods imports between the world's two largest economies have soared far beyond 100%.

The talks were still under way late on Saturday afternoon and were widely expected to continue on Sunday.

The trade dispute, combined with US President Donald Trump's decision last month to impose duties on dozens of other countries, has disrupted supply chains, unsettled financial markets and stoked fears of a sharp global downturn.

The location of the talks in the Swiss diplomatic hub was not made public. However, witnesses saw both delegations returning to the residence of Switzerland's ambassador to the UN in the leafy suburb of Coligny after a lunch break where they remained for several hours. They had met for around two hours in the morning at the gated villa which has its own private park overlooking Lake Geneva. Earlier, US officials including Bessent and US Trade Representative Jamieson Greer smiled as they left their hotel on the way to the talks, wearing red ties and American flags on their lapels. Bessent declined to speak to reporters.

At the same time, Mercedes vans with tinted windows were seen leaving a hotel where the Chinese delegation was staying on the lakeside as runners preparing for a weekend marathon warmed up in the sunshine. Washington is seeking to reduce its trade deficit with Beijing and convince China to renounce what the United States says is a mercantilist economic model and contribute more to global consumption, a shift that would require politically sensitive domestic reforms. Beijing has pushed back against what it sees as external interference. It wants Washington to lower tariffs, clarify what it wants China to buy more of, and treat it as an equal on the world stage. "China's determination to protect its national development interests is as solid as a rock, and its stance and goals in defending international fairness and justice, as well as maintaining the global economic and trade order, remain unwavering," Chinese state news agency Xinhua said in a commentary on Saturday. With distrust running high, both sides have been keen not to appear weak, and economic analysts have low expectations of a breakthrough.

US President Donald Trump said on Friday that an 80% tariff on Chinese goods "seems right", suggesting for the first time a specific alternative to the 14.5% levies he has imposed on Chinese imports.

He has suggested the discussions were initiated by China. Beijing said the U.S. requested the discussions and that China's policy of opposing US tariffs had not changed. China could be looking for the same 90-day waiver on tariffs that Washington has given other countries as negotiations take place, while any kind of tariff reduction and follow-up talks would be seen as positive by investors.

Any future terror act will be war against India: Govt

A TOP GOVERNMENT source said, "Any future act of terror in India will be considered an act of war against the country and will be responded to accordingly." An "act of war" under international law refers to a country's hostile action against another, giving the aggrieved nation a legitimate ground to target the aggressor. Four government sources also told Reuters that the Indus Waters Treaty between India and Pakistan remains suspended, despite both countries reaching a ceasefire agreement on Saturday. The treaty, mediated by the World Bank in 1960, regulates the division of water from the Indus River and its tributaries between India and Pakistan.

India had pulled out of it last month after a Pakistan-

backed attack targeting tourists in Pahalgaon. "Indus Waters Treaty was not really a part of (ceasefire) discussions," said a source from Pakistan's water ministry.

An Indian government source also told Reuters that the matter, or from officials at Pakistan's water ministry and the information minister.

Two sources from the Indian government told Reuters that all measures taken against Pakistan, including on trade and visas, would remain in place despite the pause in violence between the countries. India's foreign ministry did not immediately respond to a request for comment on the matter.

Windsor outsells Nexon, Punch

THE RECENT LAUNCH of the Windsor Pro, which features a significantly larger 52.9-kWh battery pack, is expected to further boost Windsor's lead. Market analysts suggest this could intensify the competitive pressure on Tata Motors, especially as the new arrivals position itself against not just the Nexon and Punch EVs but also Tatas newly launched Curvv EV.



Windsor EV's swift rise has been attributed to a combination of smart pricing strategies, product design, and aggressive marketing. A key factor that worked in its favour was the introduction of a battery as a service (BaaS) model. This allowed buyers to acquire the car for an initial price of ₹9.99 lakh, excluding the cost of the battery, which was offered on a pay-per-kilometre basis at ₹3.5 per km. This made the Windsor EV more financially accessible than Nexon EV, which starts at ₹12.49 lakh, and even the smaller Punch EV, priced from ₹9.99 lakh.

According to an industry expert, "This pricing strategy created a perception that consumers were getting a more spacious, premium vehicle at a more affordable price, which drew significant interest at dealerships." Windsor EV also benefitted from three notable value additions — a lifetime battery warranty for the first owner, a 60% buyback value assurance after three years or 45,000 km, and one year of free access to public charging points linked via the MG eHUB app, which covers nearly 9,000 loca-

tions across the country.

While the original Windsor EV came with a 38-kWh battery, the newly introduced Windsor Pro's 52.9-kWh capacity makes it a direct challenger to the Tata Curvv EV, which is available with 45-kWh and 55-kWh battery options. Priced from ₹17.49 lakh to ₹21.99 lakh, Curvv EV has averaged 800 units in monthly sales, but analysts believe the more aggressively priced Windsor Pro, at ₹12.49 lakh under the BaaS model and ₹17.49 lakh all-inclusive, will likely undercut Curvv's momentum. There are reports of discounts of up to ₹1.71 lakh on Curvv EV models manufactured in 2024. Although Mahindra's new EVs, BE 6 and XEV 9e, have garnered over 30,000 bookings, their premium positioning and higher battery capacities (59 kWh and 79 kWh) mean they cater to a different consumer segment.

Ukraine, European leaders agree to 30-day ceasefire on May 12

UKRAINE AND EUROPEAN leaders agreed on Saturday to an unconditional 30-day ceasefire on May 12 with the backing of US President Donald Trump, threatening President Vladimir Putin with new "massive" sanctions if he failed to comply.

The announcement was made by the leaders of Britain, France, Germany, Poland and Ukraine after a meeting in Kyiv, after which they held a phone call with Trump. The US leader, who wants a rapid peace, has not commented publicly on the course of action. "So all of us here together with the US are calling Putin out. If he is serious about peace, then he has a chance to show it," British Prime Minister Keir Starmer told reporters

at a news conference. Following through on the threat would be a dramatic sign of growing Western unity after months of unpredictable US policy that has seen Trump tear up the approach of his predecessor since entering the White House in January.

After engaging directly with Russian officials, clashing publicly with Zelensky and briefly cutting vital military aid to Ukraine, the Trump administration has patched up ties with Kyiv and signed an arduously negotiated mineral resources deal.

Kremlin: Euro countries' statements are 'confrontational'

THE KREMLIN ACCUSED European countries of making contradictory and confrontational statements, after European leaders backed a US plan for a 30-day ceasefire in Ukraine. "We hear many contradictory statements from Europe. They are generally confrontational in nature rather than aimed at trying to revive our relations. Nothing more," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said. President Putin "has said that he is ready for contacts with any leaders," Peskov said. "And is open to interaction with leaders."

7 killed, 7 BSF men among many injured in Pak shelling

A SENIOR J-K government official and a two-year-old girl, were among those killed, officials said. Residents of Jammu city and other major towns of the division woke up to air raid sirens and deafening sounds of explosions around 5 am, while the border residents spent a sleepless night in the wake of intense shelling from across the border.

Raj Kumar Thapa, additional district development commissioner, Rajouri, and his two staff members were seriously injured when an artillery shell hit his official residence in Rajouri town, the officials said. They were rushed to the Government Medical College where Thapa succumbed to his injuries, they said. Condoling Thapa's death, Chief Minister Omar Abdullah said in a post on X, "Devastating news from Rajouri. We have lost a dedicated officer of the J-K Administration Services... I've no words to express my shock & sadness at



this terrible loss of life. May his soul rest in peace." Two more persons — two-year-old Aisha Noor and Mohd Shohib (35) — were killed and three others were injured in Pakistani shelling near an industrial area in Rajouri town, the officials said. According to the officials, a 55-year-old

woman named Rashida Bi lost her life when a mortar shell hit her house at Kanghra-Galhatta village in Mendhar sector of Poonch district. In another incident, Ashok Kumar alias Shoki, a resident of Bidipur Jatta village, was killed in cross-border firing along the international border in the RS Pura sector of Jammu district, they said. Eight BSF personnel were injured in Pakistani shelling along the border in Jammu's RS Pura sector. One of them succumbed to his injuries and the rest are being treated. They are being treated at a military medical facility. Three more persons were also injured in intense shelling in Poonch and were evacuated to a hospital, officials said, adding that a local journalist was injured in the Nowshera sector of Rajouri. Several persons were injured when artillery shells and suspected drones hit some residential areas in Jammu, including Rehari and Roop Nagar in Jammu city.

What moved the needle?

RUBIO HAD ALREADY spoken to Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and the fact that he escalated it to the Pak army chief was telling. That was a late development precipitated by the events of the last 48 hours — the blackouts and the attacks on either side — is clear from the chronology. On May 1, Rubio had spoken to external affairs minister S Jaishankar and "encouraged India to work with Pakistan to de-escalate tensions and maintain peace and security in South Asia." That was seen as a perfunctory call. On May 7, shortly after India struck at nine terror locations in Pakistan and PoK, NSA Ajit Doval briefed Rubio.

On May 8, Rubio spoke to Jaishankar and emphasised the need for "immediate de-escalation". He expressed "US support for direct dialogue between India and Pakistan and encouraged continued efforts to improve communications". This series of calls set the stage for what the US state department called a "US-brokered ceasefire between India and Pakistan" in its announcement.

India insists that India and Pakistan came to an understanding bilaterally and there was "no third party involvement". Besides Rubio, US President Donald Trump and Vice-President J D Vance also talked about their role.

"Over the past 48 hours, @VP Vance and I have engaged with senior Indian and Pakistani officials, including Prime Ministers Narendra Modi and Shehbaz Sharif, EAM S Jaishankar, Chief of Army Staff Asim Munir, and National Security Advisors Ajit Doval & Asim Malik," Rubio posted on X, giving the cast of characters and the phone lines that worked between Delhi, Washington DC, Islamabad and Rawalpindi. May 8, it hit and destroyed the air defence system in Lahore. Pak's retaliation was aggressive in Jammu, Pathankot and Udhampur, as well as up to Jaisalmer. India was able to intercept about 400 drones because of its air defence system. But, then Pakistan attacked Srinagar in the early hours on May 10.

But the last three nights of tension after military hostilities, Delhi woke up on Saturday with a Pakistan attack that was intercepted in Srisa — barely 240 km from Delhi. The target of locations like Chandigarh meant that the attacks and targets by Pak on India were not just confined to the north and western sectors of the India-Pakistan border. From the Indian perspective, the strategic imperative of peace was important, after it had established superiority against Pak — by defending itself in the face of barrage of drone and missile attacks. For Pak, Gen Munir was also able to convey to his domestic audience that Rawalpindi was not taking things down, and was able to respond aggressively against India. The needle moved in Washington DC as Pak got the IMF bailout package — despite India's abstention. This gave Islamabad an off-ramp, as it was able to portray a win — despite Delhi's objections. For Delhi, an uneasy peace has been secured — redlines on "terrorism have been drawn" — as an official source said that "any terror attack in future will be deemed as an act of war", and it has clearly said that other diplomatic and economic retaliatory steps will remain in place, including the abeyance of the World Bank-brokered Indus Water Treaty. The most challenging task will be that how long will the ceasefire hold — will be upto the two militaries and the establishment in Pak, led by Gen Munir and his NSA-cum-ISI chief Lt Gen Malik.

Excess deaths in line with pre-2020 trend, says govt

INDIA'S CUMULATIVE EXCESS mortality for 2020-2021 was 9.3% higher than expected deaths, a figure which was lower than that of the US, Italy and Russia, official sources said, referring to the latest Civil Registration System (CRS) data.

Sources pointed out that the number of deaths documented in the CRS has been increasing over time, even in the years preceding the Covid-19 outbreak in 2020, they said.

The excess mortality is the additional number of deaths, due to all causes during a crisis such as Covid-19, above the number of deaths expected to be reported during "normal" conditions.

The annual increment observed in a given year, compared to the previous year, has varied from 1.3% in 2016 to 9.93% in 2019, with the average increase over three preceding years (2016 to 2019) estimated at 6.42% per annum. The annual secular increase in deaths registered in CRS can be attributed to several reasons, including a larger population cohort, maturing reporting processes and increased awareness of the need for registration, leading to higher

registration levels, sources said. The annual secular increase is the long-term, consistent increase in deaths over a year. This trend has been further accentuated over the years by the mandatory requirements for death certificates linked to pension schemes, social security benefits, and property issues. Besides, Covid-19 death compensation required death certification, prompting registration under CRS, the sources stated. "Our teams conducted preliminary analyses of CRS data to assess cumulative excess deaths in the years 2020 and 2021," an official source said. Based on the three-year (2016-19), annual rate of

increase of 6.42% mentioned above, the expected number of deaths would be 81,31,869 in 2020 and 86,54,185 in 2021.

However, the observed deaths were 81,15,882 in 2020 and 1,02,24,506 in 2021. The excess deaths, defined as observed minus expected deaths, were (-)15,987 and 15,70,321, respectively, the sources said.

"Thus, the total excess deaths over the two-year period amounted to 15,54,334. As a percentage, this is 9.3% higher than the expected deaths. This translates into about 1,249 excess deaths per one million population," the sources said.

It must be emphasised that excess deaths in these years are not equal to Covid-19 direct deaths, the source underlined.

These excess deaths include reported Covid-19 deaths (4,81,080 by the end of 2021), unreported Covid-19 deaths, deaths due to all other causes, and possible indirect effects of Covid-19. "To benchmark these estimates, subject to more nuanced future analyses, we compared cumulative excess deaths in India for 2020 and 2021 with those of selected countries that provide publicly available data on excess mortality during the same period," the source said.

Ceasefire announced, broken

"IT WAS AGREED between them that both sides would stop all firing and military action on land and in the air and sea with effect from 1700 hours Indian Standard Time today. Instructions have been given on both sides to give effect to the understanding," he added. The DGMOs will talk again at noon on May 12, he said. The United States, however, claimed credit for brokering the ceasefire.

Trump said the two countries agreed on a full and immediate ceasefire "after a long night of talks mediated by the United States". In his statement, Rubio also said India and Pakistan "have agreed... to start talks on a broad set of issues at a neutral site." This has been contested by Indian officials, who said all "coercive diplomacy measures" including the suspension of the Indus Water Treaty remain in place. External affairs minister S Jaishankar framed the ceasefire as the working out of an "understanding" between India and Pakistan. "India has consistently maintained a firm and uncompromising stance against terrorism in all its forms and manifestations. It will continue to do so," he posted.

Having drawn new redlines by conducting strikes on terror sites not just in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir but across the International Border deep inside

Pakistan, Jaishankar's assertion underlines that Islamabad will have to pay a heavy price for state-sponsored terrorism.

Sources said the decision to stop firing and military action was worked out "directly between the two countries", and there was no "third party involvement".

Any future terror act will be war against India: Govt

A TOP GOVERNMENT source said, "Any future act of terror in India will be considered an act of war against the country and will be responded to accordingly." An "act of war" under international law refers to a country's hostile action against another, giving the aggrieved nation a legitimate ground to target the aggressor. Four government sources also told Reuters that the Indus Waters Treaty between India and Pakistan remains suspended, despite both countries reaching a ceasefire agreement on Saturday. The treaty, mediated by the World Bank in 1960, regulates the division of water from the Indus River and its tributaries between India and Pakistan.

India had pulled out of it last month after a Pakistan-

backed attack targeting tourists in Pahalgam. "Indus Waters Treaty was not really a part of (ceasefire) discussions," said a source from Pakistan's water ministry.

An Indian government source also told Reuters there was "no change in stand" on the treaty. There was no immediate response from India's foreign ministry on the matter, or from officials at Pakistan's water ministry and the information minister.

Two sources from the Indian government told Reuters that all measures taken against Pakistan, including on trade and visas, would remain in place despite the pause in violence between the countries. India's foreign ministry did not immediately respond to a request for comment on the matter.

Windsor outsells Nexon, Punch

THE RECENT LAUNCH of the Windsor Pro, which features a significantly larger 52.9-kWh battery pack, is expected to further boost Windsor's lead. Market analysts suggest this could intensify the competitive pressure on Tata Motors, especially as the new variants position itself against not just the Nexon and Punch EVs but also Tata's newly launched Curvv EV.

Windsor EV's swift rise has been attributed to a combination of smart pricing strategies, product design, and aggressive marketing. A key factor that worked in its favour was the introduction of a battery as a service (BaaS) model. This allowed buyers to acquire the car for an initial price of ₹9.99 lakh, excluding the cost of the battery, which was offered on a paper-kilometre basis at ₹3.5 per km. This made the Windsor EV more financially accessible than Nexon EV, which starts at ₹12.49 lakh, and even the smaller Punch EV, priced from ₹9.99 lakh.



According to an industry expert, "This pricing strategy created a perception that consumers were getting a more spacious, premium vehicle at a more affordable price, which drew significant interest at dealerships". Windsor EV also benefitted from three notable value additions — a lifetime battery warranty for the first owner, a 60% buyback value assurance after three years or 45,000 km, and one year of free access to public charging points linked via the MG eHUB app, which covers nearly 9,000 loca-

tions across the country.

While the original Windsor EV came with a 38-kWh battery, the newly introduced Windsor Pro's 52.9-kWh capacity makes it a direct challenger to the Tata Curvv EV, which is available with 45-kWh and 55-kWh battery options. Priced from ₹17.49 lakh to ₹21.99 lakh, Curvv EV has averaged 800 units in monthly sales, but analysts believe the more aggressively priced Windsor Pro, at ₹12.49 lakh under the BaaS model and ₹17.49 lakh all-inclusive, will likely undercut Curvv's momentum. There are reports of discounts of up to ₹1.71 lakh on Curvv EV models manufactured in 2024. Although Mahindra's new EVs, BE 6 and XEV 9e, have garnered over 30,000 bookings, their premium positioning and higher battery capacities (59 kWh and 79 kWh) mean they cater to a different consumer segment.

Archery World Cup: India bag five medals



Madhura Dhamangaonkar strikes gold in Archery World Cup

CAPPING A DREAM comeback, Madhura Dhamangaonkar clinched her maiden individual World Cup gold to headline India's glittering medal collection in the compound section, two gold, one silver and two bronze at the Archery Stage 2 showpiece here on Saturday.

Unranked for being in the sidelines for three years, Madhura produced a sensational upturn in the final, edging out USA's Carson Krahe 139-138 to seal the top podium.

The 24-year-old from Armravati, Maharashtra, had earlier bagged a team silver and a mixed team bronze, completing a fine three-medal haul.

However, Madhura's individual final was a roller-coaster affair. She opened with a perfect 30, including two Xs, but faltered with two 8s in the second end and a costly 7 in the third, trailing 81-85. Krahe, ranked 52nd and a World Cup team bronze medallist last year, capitalised with a perfect 30 in the third end. Under-terred, Madhura showed nerves of steel, shooting a near-flawless 29 in the fourth to level the match at 110-10.

US-China pursue Geneva talks on easing trade war

CHINESE VICE PREMIER He Lifeng held talks with US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent on Saturday in a tentative first step towards defusing a trade war that is disrupting the global economy. Bessent and He were meeting in Geneva after weeks of growing tensions in which duties on goods imports between the world's two largest economies have soared far beyond 100%.

The talks were still under way late on Saturday afternoon and were widely expected to continue on Sunday.

The trade dispute, combined with US President Donald Trump's decision last month to impose duties on dozens of other countries, has disrupted supply chains, unsettled financial markets and stoked fears of a sharp global downturn.

The location of the talks in the Swiss diplomatic hub was not made public. However, witnesses saw both delegations returning to the residence of Switzerland's ambassador to the UN in the leafy suburb of Coligny after a lunch break where they remained for several hours. They had met for around two hours in the morning at the gated villa which has its own private park overlooking Lake Geneva. Earlier, US officials including Bessent and US Trade Representative Jamieon Greer smiled as they left their hotel on the way to the talks, wearing red ties and American flags on their lapels. Bessent declined to speak to reporters.

At the same time, Mercedes vans with tinted windows were seen leaving a hotel where the Chinese delegation was staying

on the lakeside as runners preparing for a weekend marathon warmed up in the sunshine.

Washington is seeking to reduce its trade deficit with Beijing and convince China to renounce what the United States says is a mercantilist economic model and contribute more to global consumption, a shift that would require politically sensitive domestic reforms. Beijing has pushed back against what it sees as external interference. It wants Washington to lower tariffs, clarify what it wants China to buy more of, and treat it as an equal on the world stage.

"China's determination to protect its national development interests is as solid as a rock, and its stance and goals in defending international fairness and justice, as well as maintaining the global economic and trade order, remain unwavering," Chinese state news agency Xinhua said in a commentary on Saturday. With distrust running high, both sides have been keen not to appear weak, and economic analysts have low expectations of a breakthrough.

US President Donald Trump said on Friday that an 80% tariff on Chinese goods "seems right", suggesting for the first time a specific alternative to the 145% levies he has imposed on Chinese imports.

He has suggested the discussions were initiated by China. Beijing said the US requested the discussions and that China's policy of opposing US tariffs had not changed. China could be looking for the same 90-day waiver on tariffs that Washington has given other countries as negotiations take place, while any kind of tariff reduction and follow-up talks would be seen as positive by investors.

Ukraine, European leaders agree to 30-day ceasefire on May 12

UKRAINE AND EUROPEAN leaders agreed on Saturday to an unconditional 30-day ceasefire on May 12 with the backing of US President Donald Trump, threatening President Vladimir Putin with new 'massive' sanctions if he failed to comply.

The announcement was made by the leaders of Britain, France, Germany, Poland and Ukraine after a meeting in Kyiv, after which they held a phone call with Trump. The US leader, who wants a rapid peace, has not commented publicly on the course of action. "So all of us here together with the US are calling Putin out. If he is serious about peace, then he has a chance to show it," British Prime Minister Keir Starmer told reporters

at a news conference.

Following through on the threat would be a dramatic sign of growing Western unity after months of unpredictable US policy that has seen Trump tear up the approach of his predecessor since entering the White House in January.

After engaging directly with Russian officials, clashing publicly with Zelensky and briefly cutting vital military aid to Ukraine, the Trump administration has patched up ties with Kyiv and signed an arduously-negotiated mineral resources deal.

Kremlin: Euro countries' statements are 'confrontational'

THE KREMLIN ACCUSED European countries of making contradictory and confrontational statements, after European leaders backed a US plan for a 30-day ceasefire in Ukraine. "We hear many contradictory statements from Europe. They are generally confrontational in nature rather than aimed at trying to revive our relations. Nothing more," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said. President Putin "has said that he is ready for contacts with any leaders", Peskov said. "And is open to interaction with leaders..."

Raj Kumar Thapa, additional district development commissioner, Rajouri, and his two staff members were seriously injured when an artillery shell hit his official residence in Rajouri town, the officials said. They were rushed to the Government Medical College where Thapa succumbed to his injuries, they said.

woman named Rashida Bi lost her life when a mortar shell hit her house at Kanghra-Galhatta village in Mendhar sector of Poonch district. In another incident, Ashok Kumar alias Shoki, a resident of Bidipur Jatta village, was killed in cross-border firing along the international border in the RS Pura sector of Jammu district, they said. What moved the needle?

RUBIO HAD ALREADY spoken to Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and the fact that he escalated it to the Pak army chief was telling. This series of calls set the stage for what the US state department called a "US-brokered ceasefire between India and Pakistan" in its announcement.

May 8, it hit and destroyed the air defence system in Lahore. Pak's retaliation was aggressive in Jammu, Pathankot and Udhampur, as well as upto Jaisalmer. India was able to intercept about 400 drones because of its air defence system. But, then Pakistan attacked Srinagar in the early hours on May 10.

From the Indian perspective, the strategic imperative of peace was important, after it had established superiority against Pak — by defending itself in the face of barrage of drone and missile attacks. For Pak, Gen Munir was also able to convey to his domestic audience that Rawalpindi was not taking it lying down, and was able to respond aggressively against India. The needle moved in Washington DC as Pak got the IMF bailout package — despite India's abstention. This gave Islamabad an off-ramp, as it was able to portray a win — despite Delhi's objections. For Delhi, an uneasy peace has been secured — redlines on "terrorism have been drawn" — as an official source said that "any terror attack in future will be deemed as an act of war", and it has clearly said that other diplomatic and economic retaliatory steps will remain in place, including the abeyance of the World Bank-brokered Indus Water Treaty. The most challenging task will be that how long will the ceasefire hold — will be upto the two militaries and the establishment in Pak, led by Gen Munir and his NSA-cum-ISI chief Lt Gen Malik.

INDIA'S CUMULATIVE EXCESS mortality for 2020-2021 was 9.3% higher than expected deaths, a figure which was lower than that of the US, Italy and Russia, official sources said, referring to the latest Civil Registration System (CRS) data.

Sources pointed out that the number of deaths documented in the CRS has been increasing over time, even in the years preceding the Covid-19 outbreak in 2020, they said.

The excess mortality is the additional number of deaths, due to all causes during a crisis such as Covid-19, above the number of deaths expected to be reported during "normal" conditions.

The annual increment observed in a given year, compared to the previous year, has varied from 1.3% in 2016 to 9.93% in 2019, with the average increase over three preceding years (2016 to 2019) estimated at 6.42% per annum. The annual secular increase in deaths registered in CRS can be attributed to several reasons, including a larger population cohort, maturing reporting processes and increased awareness of the need for registration, leading to higher

Any future terror act will be war against India: Govt

A TOP GOVERNMENT source said, "Any future act of terror in India will be considered an act of war against the country and will be responded to accordingly." An "act of war" under international law refers to a country's hostile action against another, giving to the aggrieved nation a legitimate ground to target the aggressor. Four government sources also told Reuters that the Indus Waters Treaty between India and Pakistan remains suspended, despite both countries reaching a ceasefire agreement on Saturday. The treaty, mediated by the World Bank in 1960, regulates the division of water from the Indus River and its tributaries between India and Pakistan.

Windsor outsells Nexon, Punch

Priced from ₹17.49 lakh to ₹21.99 lakh, Curvv EV has averaged 800 units in monthly sales, but analysts believe the more aggressively priced Windsor Pro, at ₹12.49 lakh under the BaaS model and ₹17.49 lakh all-inclusive, will likely undercut Curvv's momentum. There are reports of discounts of up to ₹1.71 lakh on Curvv EV models manufactured in 2024. Although Mahindra's new EVs, BE 6 and XEV 9e, have garnered over 30,000 bookings, their premium positioning and higher battery capacities (59 kWh and 79 kWh) mean they cater to a different consumer segment.

Archery World Cup: India bag five medals



Madhura Dhamangaonkar strikes gold in Archery World Cup

CAPPING A DREAM comeback, Madhura Dhamangaonkar clinched her maiden individual World Cup gold to headline India's glittering medal collection in the compound section, two gold, one silver and two bronze at the Archery Stage 2 showpiece here on Saturday. Unranked for being in the sidelines for three years, Madhura produced a sensational upturn in the final, edging out USA's Carson Krahe 139-138 to seal the top podium.

The 24-year-old from Amravati, Maharashtra, had earlier bagged a team silver and a mixed team bronze, completing a fine three-medal haul. However, Madhura's individual final was a roller-coaster affair. She opened with a perfect 30, including two Xs, but faltered with two 8s in the second end and a costly 7 in the third, trailing 81-85. Krahe, ranked 52nd and a World Cup team bronze medalist last year, capitalised with a perfect 30 in the third end. Undeterred, Madhura showed nerves of steel, shooting a near-flawless 29 in the fourth to level the match at 110-111.

US-China pursue Geneva talks on easing trade war

CHINESE VICE PREMIER He Lifeng held talks with US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent on Saturday in a tentative first step towards defusing a trade war that is disrupting the global economy. Bessent and He were meeting in Geneva after weeks of growing tensions in which duties on goods imports between the world's two largest economies have soared far beyond 100%.

The talks were still under way late on Saturday afternoon and were widely expected to continue on Sunday. The trade dispute, combined with US President Donald Trump's decision last month to impose duties on dozens of other countries, has disrupted supply chains, unsettled financial markets and stoked fears of a sharp global downturn.

The location of the talks in the Swiss diplomatic hub was not made public. However, witnesses saw both delegations returning to the residence of Switzerland's ambassador to the UN in the leafy suburb of Coligny after a lunch break where they remained for several hours. They had met for around two hours in the morning at the gated villa which has its own private park overlooking Lake Geneva. Earlier, US officials including Bessent and US Trade Representative Jamieson Greer smiled as they left their hotel on the way to the talks, wearing red ties and American flags on their lapels. Bessent declined to speak to reporters.

At the same time, Mercedes vans with tinted windows were seen leaving a hotel where the Chinese delegation was staying on the lakeside as runners preparing for a weekend marathon warmed up in the sunshine. Washington is seeking to reduce its trade deficit with Beijing and convince China to renounce what the United States says is a mercantilist economic model and contribute more to global consumption, a shift that would require politically sensitive domestic reforms. Beijing has pushed back against what it sees as external interference. It wants Washington to lower tariffs, clarify what it wants China to buy more of, and treat it as an equal on the world stage. "China's determination to protect its national development interests is as solid as a rock, and its stance and goals in defending international fairness and justice, as well as maintaining the global economic and trade order, remain unwavering," Chinese state news agency Xinhua said in a commentary on Saturday. With distrust running high, both sides have been keen not to appear weak, and economic analysts have low expectations of a breakthrough. US President Donald Trump said on Friday that an 80% tariff on Chinese goods "seems right", suggesting for the first time a specific alternative to the 14.5% levies he has imposed on Chinese imports. He has suggested the discussions were initiated by China. Beijing said the U.S. requested the discussions and that China's policy of opposing US tariffs had not changed. China could be looking for the same 90-day waiver on tariffs that Washington has given other countries as negotiations take place, while any kind of tariff reduction and follow-up talks would be seen as positive by investors.

Ukraine, European leaders agree to 30-day ceasefire on May 12

UKRAINE AND EUROPEAN leaders agreed on Saturday to an unconditional 30-day ceasefire on May 12 with the backing of US President Donald Trump, threatening President Vladimir Putin with new 'massive' sanctions if he failed to comply. The announcement was made by the leaders of Britain, France, Germany, Poland and Ukraine after a meeting in Kyiv, after which they held a phone call with Trump. The US leader, who wants a rapid peace, has not commented publicly on the course of action. "So all of us here together with the US are calling Putin out. If he is serious about peace, then he has a chance to show it," British Prime Minister Keir Starmer told reporters

at a news conference. Following through on the threat would be a dramatic sign of growing Western unity after months of unpredictable US policy that has seen Trump tear up the approach of his predecessor since entering the White House in January. After engaging directly with Russian officials, clashing publicly with Zelensky and briefly cutting vital military aid to Ukraine, the Trump administration has patched up ties with Kyiv and signed an arduously-negotiated mineral resources deal.

Kremlin: Euro countries' statements are 'confrontational'

THE KREMLIN ACCUSED European countries of making contradictory and confrontational statements, after European leaders backed a US plan for a 30-day ceasefire in Ukraine. "We hear many contradictory statements from Europe. They are generally confrontational in nature rather than aimed at trying to revive our relations. Nothing more," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said. President Putin "has said that he is ready for contacts with any leaders", Peskov said. "And is open to interaction with leaders..."

ભાવેશભાઈ કનુભાઈ કાછરીયા (ઉ.વ. 42), જેઓ બાંધકામના વ્યવસાય સાથે સંકળાયેલા છે અને સુરતના સરથાણા વિસ્તારમાં રહે છે, તેમણે વિક્રમભાઈ રામભાઈ સાંબડ (હાલ રહે. અમરોલી છાપરાભાડા શાંતીકુંજ સોસાયટી રૂમ નં.44 સુરત શહેર મૂળ રહે. સણોસરા તા.સીહોર જી.ભાવનગર), જીતુભાઈ જોગાભાઈ સાંબડ (હાલ રહે. અમરોલી, છાપરા ભાડા, શાંતીકુંજ સોસાયટી, રૂમ નં.45, સુરત શહેર મૂળ રહે.સણોસરા તા.સીહોર જી.ભાવનગર) અને મુકેશભાઈ માનસિંગભાઈ રબારી (હાલ રહે- વિષ્ણુદેવી, અમદાવાદ તેમજ 223- ગુજરાત હાઉસિંગ બોર્ડ, તાડવાડી, છાપરા ભાડા રોડ, વરીયાવ, સુરત) નામના ત્રણ વ્યક્તિ સામે ફરિયાદ નોંધાવી છે.
